

Appearance Commission

The Appearance Commission studies the visual problems and needs of the Town as well as the ETJ planning/zoning jurisdiction. This commission plans and carries out programs to enhance and improve the visual quality and aesthetic characteristics of the Town and the extraterritorial jurisdiction beyond the Town limits.

Some examples of this are:

- assisting in the implementation of programs of general community beautification
- to provide leadership and guidance in matters of community design and appearance to individual, organizations and agencies
- to make studies of the visual characteristics and problems of the Town, including surveys and inventories

The Commission has 13 members appointed by the Town Council – 10 members being residents of the Town and three being residents of Moore County within the ETJ.
