



Mt Hope Cemetery

Hector McNeil and his wife were possibly the first settlers to live in the area that would be known as Southern Pines (as recorded in the 1755 census).

Descendants of those first residents established a burial ground on a pine covered knoll off Morganton Road. More than century later, this burial ground became the Town of Southern Pines municipal cemetery named Mt. Hope.

The Town opened a new section in 1995 to add 610 grave sites.


Maintained by the Town of Southern Pines, Mt. Hope Cemetery is located at 405 W. Morganton Rd. at the junction with US Highway 1.

casket.**


Plot fees are:

**Single plot: \$750
(\$1,500 for non-residents)**

**Double plot: \$1,000
(\$2,000 for non-residents)**
