MAYORAL PROCLAMATION

*Town of Southern Pines, Office of the Mayor*

**THAT WHEREAS**, we have determined that a State of Emergency, as defined in Chapter 93, Section 93.02 of the Town of Southern Pines Code of Ordinances, exists in the Town of Southern Pines, North Carolina due to Hurricane Matthew which threatens to cause significant damage to Southern Pines and the surrounding area. Damage could include but is not limited to: flooding, hurricane force winds, downed trees, downed powerlines, power outages and substantial property damage.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to General Statute 166A and Chapter 93 of the Town of Southern Pines Code of Ordinances, I hereby proclaim a "State of Emergency" in the Town of Southern Pines;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W David McNeill, Jr. Mayor of the Town of Southern Pines, North Carolina, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. The following initialed restrictions be put in place in the Town of Southern Pines:

1. Prohibit or regulate the buying or selling of beer, wine, or intoxicating beverages of any kind, and their possession or consumption off one's own premises;
2. Prohibit or regulate any demonstration, parade, march, vigil or participation therein from taking place on any of the public ways or upon any public property;
3. Prohibit or regulate the sale of gasoline, kerosene, naphtha, or any other explosive or inflammable fluids or substances;
- X   4. Prohibit or regulate travel upon any street, alley, or roadway or upon any other public property, except by those in search of medical assistance, food or any other commodity or service necessary to sustain the well-being of themselves or their families or some member thereof;

\_\_\_\_\_5. Prohibit or regulate the participation in or carrying on of any business activity, and prohibit or regulate the keeping open of places of business, places of entertainment, and any other places of public assembly.

**SECTION 2.** All Town of Southern Pines officials and agencies are to cooperate in the implementation of this Proclamation and the provisions of the Moore County Emergency Operations Plan and the Town of Southern Pines Emergency Operation Planning Guideline.

This Proclamation shall become effective immediately and shall automatically expire within ninety-six (96) hours. Proclaimed this the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2016, at 8:00 A.M. Eastern Standard Time.

## MAYORAL PROCLAMATION

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W David McNeill, Jr. Mayor of the Town of Southern Pines, North Carolina, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. The following initialed restrictions be put in place in the Town of Southern Pines:

\_\_\_\_ 1. Prohibit or regulate the buying or selling of beer, wine, or intoxicating beverages of any kind, and their possession or consumption off one's own premises;

\_\_\_\_ 2. Prohibit or regulate any demonstration, parade, march, vigil or participation therein from taking place on any of the public ways or upon any public property;

\_\_\_\_ 3. Prohibit or regulate the sale of gasoline, kerosene, naphtha, or any other explosive or inflammable fluids or substances;

X  4. Prohibit or regulate travel upon any street, alley, or roadway or upon any other public property, except by those in search of medical assistance, food or any other commodity or service necessary to sustain the well-being of themselves or their families or some member thereof;

\_\_\_\_\_5. Prohibit or regulate the participation in or carrying on of any business activity, and prohibit or regulate the keeping open of places of business, places of entertainment, and any other places of public assembly.

**SECTION 2.** All Town of Southern Pines officials and agencies are to cooperate in the implementation of this Proclamation and the provisions of the Moore County Emergency Operations Plan and the Town of Southern Pines Emergency Operation Planning Guideline.

This Proclamation shall become effective immediately and shall automatically expire within ninety-six (96) hours. Proclaimed this the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2016, at 8:00 A.M. Eastern Standard Time.
