The North Carolina Department of Transportation, the Village of Pinehurst, the Town of Southern Pines, and Moore County are partnering to hold a public meeting to provide an update on the Midland Road corridor study. The purpose of this study is to address transportation and safety concerns and evaluate improvement alternatives from Airport Road in Pinehurst to Clark Street in Southern Pines. The study corridor is approximately 4.4 miles long.

Interested citizens may attend at any time during the hours mentioned to the right. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the study. The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by November 6, 2017. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
