Notification #5 Regarding State of Emergency and Facility Closings

With continued recognition of a State of Emergency throughout North Carolina and Moore County, at this time the Town of Southern Pines announces the following change to our current operations:

- 1. All Facility Closures and Program Suspensions originally scheduled to expire on March 28th are hereby extended until further Notice.**

Residents are urged to follow State mandates, CDC and Moore County Health Department guidelines in the avoidance of gatherings and practice of safe distancing. The Town will continue to monitor this evolving situation, and other closings, cancellations, and service changes may follow. Citizens, patrons, and customers are asked to utilize on-line resources, the telephone, secured drop-boxes, and other alternative methods of business so as to minimize both their personal contacts and out of respect for Town staff and their respective families.
