Rules:

- Each entrant (solo or group) is allowed to submit one house.
- All gingerbread houses must be 100% edible. Non-edible support structure materials other than the baseboard may not be used.
- Non-edible decorations, like paint, ribbon, figurines, etc. may be used **ONLY** to decorate your base.
- New this year* Pictures of your houses will be submitted for the competition. You will **NOT** need to bring your gingerbread house to the park or turn it in.
- Registration forms and pictures must be turned in via email by **Fri | Dec 1 at 12pm**

- In the picture, please include: Contestant's Name, Gingerbread house name, and age group.
- Pictures of Gingerbread houses will be displayed at Downtown Park basketball court on Sat | Dec 2 at 10am.

We will have 1 category this year: Most unique. The winner will be chosen by "People's Choice". During the parade, pictures will be set up at the Downtown Park. People will be able to vote on their favorite house. The house with the most votes for each age group will win.
