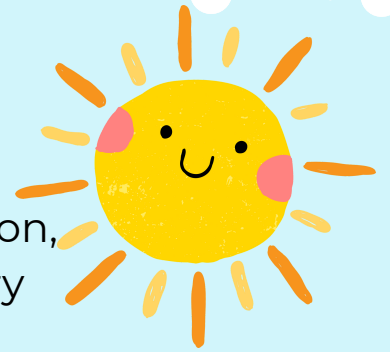


Early Childhood Programs
