WHAT?

The Warrior Woods Lift Station is the largest sewer station operated by the Town. It serves a 7.7 square mile area, which is 41% of the overall Town. The station can pump up to 900 gallons per minute of sewer.

When?

The project is underway now, having started in early August. Completion of the new lift station is expected to take a year finishing late summer 2025.

WHERE?

The station is located near the corner of the Cherokee Drive and Warrior Woods Road in the Warrior Woods neighborhood, adjacent to Mill Creek.

WHY?

This critical lift station is located in the 100 year flood plain and is being relocated to protect the facility from future storm damage.

Who?

The Town is leading and funding this project.

The engineering firm WithersRavenel has designed the project and a Carolina Civil Works is doing the construction work.

The estimated cost is \$2,998,000. The Town has received a low-interest loan (1.18%) from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund.
