SOUTHERN PINES, N.C. — The Pages of the Pines Author Festival returns to Southern Pines on March 21, bringing together local and regional writers, readers, for a day celebrating storytelling, creativity, and community — highlighted by a featured talk from New York Times bestselling author Megan Church.

This year's festival includes an exciting new partnership with the Weymouth Center for the Arts & Humanities, pairing Pages of the Pines with the Center's Spring into Reading celebration to expand literary programming across the community.

Church, known for her nationally acclaimed novels and emotional storytelling, will deliver an author talk on Saturday afternoon, offering attendees a rare opportunity to hear directly from a bestselling writer about her work and creative process.

In addition to the featured presentation, the festival will showcase independent authors across multiple genres, providing opportunities for book signings, conversations with writers, and community engagement centered around reading.

Pages of the Pines is designed to spotlight regional talent while creating a welcoming environment for readers of all ages. Organizers hope the expanded format and special guest appearance will draw new audiences and deepen the festival's impact.





