



Sidewalk Construction Project

The Town of Southern Pines, in its efforts to improving the walk-ability of our community, has signed a contract with **Sandhills Contractors** to install sidewalks along several blocks in our residential areas. The contractor will begin construction of this sidewalk project near your residence on or about **March 1st**.

The following information will answer some questions you may have about what you can expect during construction.

If you have any items located within the highway right-of-way, such as flowerpots, bushes, signs, or any other personal items, please remove them before construction begins.

Our commitment to you




The nature of this work sometimes makes it necessary to temporarily limit access to driveways. During construction, the contractor will be required to maintain access that will provide a safe means of entry onto your property that will protect your customers, the construction personnel, and the new construction as it is being installed.


You will be notified in advance of any impact of the construction that may cause inconveniences to you.

Heavy Construction Equipment

The contractor may store and use heavy construction vehicles, such as dump trucks, concrete trucks, trenching and earth moving equipment, within the work area for the duration of the project. Because they can be loud during operations, no work will be conducted at night.



Safety



The contractor is required to keep all work areas safe. Please use caution as you enter and exit your property.



Storing Materials and Debris

The contractor has permission to use areas within the right-of-way to store materials needed for the construction of this project. These stored materials can be unattractive, but will either be used in the construction or hauled away.
