



2022 Gingerbread House Competition

Rules:

- Each entrant (solo or group) is allowed to submit one house.
- All gingerbread houses must be 100% edible. Non-edible support structure materials other than the baseboard may not be used.
- Non-edible decorations, like paint, ribbon, figurines, etc. may be used ONLY to decorate your base.
- Gingerbread houses must be supported with a strong base. (Plywood preferred)
- Please include your name and gingerbread house title on the bottom of the base.
- Registration forms must be turned (via email or dropped at office) by **Fri | Dec 2 at 12pm**
- Gingerbread houses must be dropped off no later than **Sat | Dec 3 at 10am** at the Downtown Park basketball court | 145 SE Broad St
- All houses must be picked up by 12:30pm on Sat, Dec 3 (after the parade). Houses not picked up will be disposed of.

Scoring:

We will have 2 categories this year: Most unique and Fave Southern Pines Location. The winner will be chosen by "People's Choice". During the parade, houses will be set up at the Downtown Park. People will be able to vote on their favorite house. The house with the most votes for each age group will win.
